

The Upper Room Campaign

October 25-October 31, 2020

Week 1

Introduction: This week we will begin our Upper Room Campaign. Just like the disciples and the early church spent time together in prayer before the Day of Pentecost, our emphasis during this time is for us to spend more time in prayer both privately and corporately. Two things are required for success in God's work: prayer and work. We are going to emphasize the first in this campaign.

Day One – October 25th – Enrollment In Christ's School Of Prayer (Luke 11:1)

In our Sunday Evening Services, this message will be preached with the emphasis of each of us enrolling in Christ's School of Prayer, learning from our Savior the ministry of prayer.

- Lord, I enroll in Thy School Of Prayer
- Fill me with faith to pray
- Make me strong in faith

Day Two – October 26th – God Is Seeking True Worshipers (John 4:23-24)

There will be a message posted on Facebook and on our website with this message on the worshippers God seeks to have.

- Lord, I desire to grow in my fellowship with thee
- Lord, I will take the lessons as they come
- Lord, may I be a true worshiper that worships Thee in Spirit and in Truth

Day Three – October 27th – Alone With God (Matthew 6:6)

This message (on Facebook and on our website) emphasizes the need of being alone with God: to have a place of prayer and a time when you meet God each day.

- Lord, I will establish a place to pray and a time to pray
- Lord, I will overcome the personal hindrances and continue in personal prayer

Day Four – October 28th – The Model Prayer (Matthew 6:9-13)

Brian Treadway will be preaching in our evening services. Since this passage has been preached many times in our church, I want to encourage you to go over this passage and allow the Holy Spirit to speak to you concerning this very important passage on prayer.

Day Five – October 29th – Certainty Of Answered Prayer (Matthew 7:7-8)

This passage, along with yesterday's passage will be covered in our message on Facebook and on our website.

- I will start a prayer list with specific requests to bring before the Lord, or
- I will update my prayer list

Day Six – October 30th – God Our Father, The Giver Of Good Gifts (Matthew 7:9-11)

This passage teaches us that our God is a good God and a benevolent Father, who desires to give good gifts to His children.

- I will review the commitments I've made so far in this series this week
- I will strive to grow in my fellowship with the Lord in prayer
- I will seek to walk with God throughout the day

Day Seven – October 31st – The Holy Spirit, The All-Comprehensive Gift (Luke 11:13)

This final lesson for the week is on the filling of the Holy Spirit.

- I will seek to be a Spirit Filled Christian
- I will pray for the Lord to fill me with His Spirit
- I will obey the Lord as He leads me

Conclusion: Starting today, spend time each day going over the passage of Scripture and the lesson for the day, and set aside a time for prayer each day. Listen to the messages each day, whether in church or on Facebook or our website (www.orangeburgbaptist.com). If you have not started on the prescribed dates, start where you are, and, if possible, do a morning and an evening time until you catch up. For further study, I would recommend you getting Andrew Murray's book, With Christ In The School Of Prayer and study each lesson, using the KJV.
