November 1 – November 7, 2020

Week 2

Introduction: This week we will continue in our progress in Christ's School of Prayer. In the message we will go back to the Father's desire to have true worshippers, which is the basis of our prayer, worship, and service. Each day this week, we will build upon the previous days as we grow in our prayer ministry.

Day One – November 1st – The Boldness Of God's Friends (Luke 11:5-8)

This is another passage that I have preached through many times. Take time in this passage and see what the Lord gives you.

- Lord, like Abraham, I desire to be a friend of God.
- As your friend, I desire to learn the importance of importune praying.

Day Two – November 2nd – Praying For Laborers (Matthew 9:37-38)

There is not a ministry that does not need more laborers. That need is met through prayer.

- Lord, I pray for the harvest
- Lord, I pray for laborers for the harvest
- Lord, I am willing to be one of your laborers that you send forth.

Day Three – November 3rd – Definite Praying (Mark 10:51; Luke 18:41)

As the blind man who prayed for his sight, we must become definite in our requests brought before the Lord.

- Lord, I will become definite in my requests I bring to you
- Lord, I will trust you to answer according to Thy will

Day Four – November 4th – The Faith That Receives (Mark 11:24)

This will be the message that will be brought in tonight's services.

Day Five – November 5th – Believing Prayer (Mark 11:22-24)

Prayer accompanied by faith accomplished much. Our faith is not in the promise, but in the Promiser.

- Lord, may I learn to have faith in Thee, above the promises that you give.
- Lord, it is not the prayer that succeeds, but the God we pray to that answers prayer: may I remember this

Day Six – November 6th – The Cure Of Unbelief (Matthew 17:19-21)

This passage teaches the importance of fasting and prayer. There are some things that do not take place without the three-cord rope of fasting, prayer, and the power of the Holy Spirit

- I will learn to bring my serious needs to the Lord
- If physically able, I will bring my unbelief to the Lord in fasting and prayer.
- I will make supplications on behalf of my family and friends.

Day Seven – November 7st – Prayer And Forgiveness (Mark 11:25)

Prayer and forgiveness is very powerful; prayer without forgiveness is very inept.

- I will seek God's forgiveness of my sins
- I will forgive those that have sinned against me
- Where I struggle in the area of forgiveness, I will rely upon the Lord to "pull me through."

Conclusion: Starting today, spend time each day going over the passage of Scripture and the lesson for the day, and set aside a time for prayer each day. Listen to the messages each day, whether in church or on Facebook or our website (www.orangeburgbaptist.com). If you have not started on the prescribed dates, start where you are by getting week one of the outline before proceeding to this week, and, if possible, do a morning and an evening time until you catch up. For further study, I would recommend you getting Andrew Murray's book, With Christ In The School Of Prayer and study each lesson, using the KJV.
