

The Upper Room Campaign

November 15 – November 22, 2020

Week 4

Introduction: This week we will conclude our Upper Room Campaign, concluding with the final lesson on “A Life Of Prayer.” You will notice the increased progression in our relationship with Christ is emphasized in these final lessons.

Day One – November 15th – The Word Of God And Prayer (John 15:7)

There are two important things that must take place if we are to grow strong in our fellowship with Christ in prayer.

- Lord, I will abide in thee.
- Lord, I will allow Thy Word to abide in me.

Day Two – November 16th – The Obedience Of Faith; The Power In Prayer (John 15:16; James 5:16)

When we obey by faith, we will bear fruit for God’s glory.

- Lord, I demonstrate my faith by my obedience to you.
- Lord, I desire to bear fruit for Thy glory.

Day Three – November 17th– The Prevailing Plea (John 14:13-14; 15:16; 16:23-24,26)

What is the prevailing plea we have in prayer? This plea is praying in Jesus’ name.

- Lord, I will pray in Jesus’ name, knowing that this is more than just a “catch phrase,” but that I am praying according to your being and your promises.

Day Four – November 18th – The Holy Spirit And Prayer (John 16:23-26; Jude 20-21)

This will be the message that will be brought in tonight’s services.

Day Five – November 19th – Christ The Intercessor (Luke 22:32; John 16:26; Hebrews 7:25)

There are two people that pray for us always: Christ and the Holy Ghost. Praise the Lord.

- Lord, I will take comfort in the truth that You pray for me.
- Lord, I will intercede for others.

Day Six – November 20th – Christ The High Priest (John 17:24)

In this chapter we see Christ our great High Priest praying to the Father. This is a picture of how He intercedes for us today.

- Lord, I’m thankful that I have a High Priest that is touched with the feelings of my infirmities.
- Lord, I will pray for others, following Christ’s example of intercession.

Day Seven – November 21st – Christ, Our Sacrifice (Mark 14:36)

All we are, have, and do, is because of His sacrifice for us on Calvary.

- I will stand by faith on Christ’s shed blood.
- I will rest by faith on Christ’s sacrifice.

Day Eight – November 22nd – Confidence In Prayer (I John 5:14-15)

Because of Christ’s sacrifice for us, and our faith in Christ as our Savior, we can have confidence that He hears and that He will answer our prayer.

- I will pray in confidence that Christ paved the way to God.
- I will come boldly to God in prayer (Hebrews 4:16).

FINAL LESSON – The Ministry of Intercession, Sunday PM Service Message

Conclusion: Starting today, spend time each day going over the passage of Scripture and the lesson for the day, and set aside a time for prayer each day. Listen to the messages each day, whether in church or on Facebook or our website (www.orangeburgbaptist.com). If you have not started on the prescribed dates, start where you are by getting week one of the outline before proceeding to this week, and, if possible, do a morning and an evening time until you catch up. For further study, I would recommend you getting Andrew Murray’s book, With Christ In The School Of Prayer and study each lesson, using the KJV.
